New Features

Public Folders migration

Limitations:

- If the file type is not available for SharePoint site, it will not be migrated by the tool.
- Outlook 2003 SP1 patch is needed to get the Email related information.
- Public Folders migration can be installed via fresh install. To install on an existing DocAve installation, upgrade to the latest DocAve server patch, uninstall existing DocAve client via Add/Remove programs, and install latest client package.
