Improvements and New Features

General

- **New Packaging / Licensing Format**

With the release of DocAve 4.5.2, the basic Demo package and Small Business Edition have been incorporated into the ProDemo package. All modules and features of the DocAve GUI are now controlled by license only.

- **Customer Experience Improvement Program (CEIP)**

AvePoint has implemented a new program for our customers called the CEIP. This will assist us in directing future developments and updates based upon our customers' needs. Please see the "About CEIP" document in the DocAve Patch Manager for more information.

Control Panel

- **Viewing License Information**

Users can now preview their licenses from the DocAve GUI before applying them. Also available for preview is the amount of content that has been migrated, with an indication of the amount of content still remaining in the license.

- **SCOM / MOM Support Enhancement**

Along with DocAve's current Microsoft Operations Manager support, users can now send reports to the System Center Operations Manager. Logs will contain more detailed info regarding when a job starts, finishes, completes with errors, or fails.

- **Tree Mode for Large Environments**

In the previous version, DocAve implemented a "Mixed Mode" (a combination of list and tree mode for browsing data). This feature has been merged into "Tree Mode," allowing administrators of large environments to view the tree structure split over multiple pages.

- **DocAve's System Recovery Enhancement**

When backing up the DocAve platform, media server indices are now also included in order to recover full text searching ability.

Data Protection

- **Restore to File System**

DocAve's Item Level restore functionality now allows you to restore out-of-place to any file system (local or network drive). Files no longer need to be restored directly to a SharePoint environment.

- **MySite Support for SPS 2003**

Item Level backup and restore for SharePoint 2003 environments can now support the "MySite" format.

- **Platform Recovery - Major Changes!**

Platform Recovery has been redeployed as a Platform Level backup and restore. Along with this redeployment is a significant increase in the level of granularity on restore. Users can now restore on the site, subsite, folder, item, and even item version level!

- **Https Support**

Platform level restore can now perform an out-of-place restore of web applications using "https" for increased security.

SharePoint Administrator

- **Discovery Search Enhancement**

Discovery now allows you to view your SharePoint deployments across any range of domains or IP addresses, regardless of whether a DocAve Agent is installed or not.

- **SP-Admin Offline Search Mode**

Users can now run searches from Administrator without having to keep the DocAve GUI open. Results will be displayed from the Job Monitor, where all Central Administrator and Security settings can still be applied to the result.

- **Generate Report to New Formats**

Reports generated from the SharePoint Administrator can now be exported to “.pdf;” “.csv;” and “.xml” formats. These reports also have the added ability to check the SQL database size and free space.

- **Search Functionality for Extension Archiver**

Archived content from the Extension Archiver can now be searched using the native SharePoint search module. Extra tools are no longer required for searching for content.

- **Extension Archiver Enhanced Metadata Support**

Administrator’s Extension Archiver now allows you to specify a greater number of filters based on metadata, both custom and native to SharePoint.

Replicator

- **Replication of MySite properties**

Replicator can now replicate properties of MySites.

Compliance

- **New Layout of Compliance Manager**

Compliance has implemented a condensed rule builder for Archiver and Auditor to allow for easier management of plans. Please take note of the changes to the navigation panel in the GUI. These are described in depth in the User Guide.

- **Auditor Enhancements**

The destination for Audit data can now be configured to any location under the media server, saving space on the DocAve server.

*Note: Previous Auditor 2007 customers will need to contact support to ensure all audit data is migrated successfully from its original database to the media server.

Migration

- **Migrated Data Counter**

DocAve has implemented an improved data counter for the Migrator module, achieving a more accurate evaluation of the amount of content migrated.

- **SharePoint Migration enhancements**

The SharePoint 2003 to MOSS 2007 migrator now supports the migration of “My Links,” as well as SharePoint 2003 Archiver stubs.

- **eRoom Migrator Integrity Check**

The migration module for eRoom now provides optional data-integrity checking. Each file's contents are cross checked between the source and the destination, ensuring no data corruption has taken place.

- **New eRoom Mapping Ability**

DocAve's eRoom migrator now allows you to perform advanced mapping settings via custom ".xml" files. These files can be compiled into master lists for frequent migration plans. Please see the User Guide for instructions on implementing this feature.

Bug Fixes

Control Panel

- **Storage Manager**

Under the Storage Manager, the default physical drive could not be modified for use of an IBM TSM Server or File System as a Media Server.

Data Protection

- **Data Size calculation for Backup and Recovery**

The previous version of DocAve was not able to calculate the size of data older than the patch. This is now supported in the backup and recovery controllers.

Administration

- **Permissions of Invalid Users**

The previous version of DocAve allowed administrators to add invalid users to sites in batch mode.

- **Extension Archiver Index**

Previously, "*.doc" files (Microsoft Word Documents) could not be indexed using the "Generate Index" function of Extension Archiver.

Migration

- **eRoom Migrator**

Performing a migration of a document library containing files and folders would not maintain the "Folder Creation" time stamp.

Known Issues

Administration

- **Discovery's Search Mode Limit**

If the search results include more than 500 instances during an IP range search, the results will not be displayed properly.

- **Admin (Search Mode) Security Search Limit**

The Security Search function cannot return more than 2000 search results. Please use a more specific search scope or filter to narrow the results.

- **"Site Use" Confirmation and Deletion**

In order to use the "Site Use" function in the SharePoint Administrator, the "Send e-mail notifications to owners of unused site collections" option must first be checked in the SharePoint Environment

Control Panel

- **SCOM support**

In order to use the SCOM logging settings, you must use an Active Directory account and password in the DocAve Server Configuration Tool that has permission to install SCOM.

Migration

- **Incremental Live Migration of MyLinks**

DocAve's Live Migrator for SharePoint 2003 to 2007 does not currently support incremental migration of "MyLinks." A full migration must be run instead.
