Improvements and New Features

Data Protection

- **Platform Level Restore Enhancement**

The DocAve Platform Level Restore Controller now gives users the ability to perform an out-of-place restore on the Shared Search Index. Details on performing this restore can be seen in the updated User Guide.

- **“Replace” Option for Item Level Restore**

Currently, the DocAve restore controller offers options to Append, Not-Overwrite, and Overwrite (described in detail in the User Guide). The new “Replace” option will allow people to delete the destination before performing a restore (list-level and above).

Administration

- **Content Manager Module**

The Content Manager module has been reintroduced to DocAve 4.5 (formerly in version 4.1). This will now allow users to efficiently reorganize their SharePoint environment, while performing promotion and demotion of sites and subsites. This will be available free to all former 4.1 Content Manager or 4.5.2 Replicator users.

- **Replicator Enhancement**

The DocAve Replicator module now supports one-to-many replication of content within the same farm (as well as its current cross-farm replication functionality). Two way replication, byte level differencing, and other advanced features will continue to be supported. However, Replicator will now be capable only of same-level-moves (i.e., list-to-list, site-to-site, etc.).

- **Replication of Extension Archiver Stubs**

Users will now be given the option of whether to replicate stubs of archived content (created using the DocAve Extension Archiver) during replication jobs. This will give greater control to end users during the replication process.

- **Extension Archiver Browser**

Now, the 2003 and 2007 versions of DocAve's Extension Archiver will allow users to browse content in both the list and filter modes (offered in DocAve's backup module).

- **SharePoint 2003 Archiver Rule Enhancement**

The SharePoint 2003 Archiver module now contains rules based on custom metadata (custom columns).

- **Cloning Permissions in SharePoint Administrator**

DocAve users can now use the SPAdmin module to clone permissions from user-to-user, or to clone site permissions from one site to another.

- **SharePoint Administrator Security Search**

Now, security search results can be exported to .PDF, .CSV, and .XML files.

Compliance

- **Audit Exclusion Rules**

Compliance Auditor can now either audit select users, or exclude specific users from audit data.

Migration

- **Mapping Configuration Interface**

Users of File System Migrator will now be able to control mapping options directly from the GUI, making editing permissions a more straight-forward process. Configuration XML files loaded in the eRoom migrator will now have an easier time locating these files using the new "Upload" and "Download" buttons.

- **eRoom Staging**

Content from the eRoom environment can now be exported to a staging location before performing the migration to SharePoint. This will offer customers greater flexibility in performing migration jobs.

General / Control Panel

- **Disabling Scheduled Jobs**

A scheduled job can be directly canceled from the Job Monitor, without having to alter a plan. This applies to all modules.

- **Granular SharePoint Administrator Permissions**

When granting user groups permissions from the DocAve interface, administrators can now see a granular list of all SPAdmin functions. Users can be granted granular control of SP admin on all levels offered for both regular administration tasks and security operations.

Bug Fixes

Migration

- **eRoom Migrator “Check-Out” Support**

Occasionally after performing a migration, the check-out version history and check-out times did not correspond.

Administration

- **STSADM Scheduling Difficulty**

Formerly, users had to schedule a time before being able to run an STSADM command. This has been resolved.

Known Issues

General

- **Upgrade Version Compatibility**

DocAve 4.5.3.0 can only be patch-upgraded from version 4.5.2.0 or higher. Previous versions must upgrade to 4.5.2 first, or perform a fresh install.

Data Protection

- **High Availability Project Web Access Support**

The High Availability module does not restore incremental or differential PWA backup data when using the VSS snapshot backup method.

Administration

- **Existing Replicator Plans using Throttle Control**

Due to a change in the engine supporting the Replicator throttle control, users must re-create existing plans that utilized the throttle control function.

- **Content Manager**

When using the Native Mode, the children must manually be selected after choosing a parent node. These will not be selected by default.

- **Extension Archiver Web Part**

In order to update the Extension Archiver Web Part when upgrading from 4.5.2 to 4.5.3, you must open the “Client Configuration Tool” (under the Start Menu) and un-check the “Extension Archiver for MOSS 2007” option. After confirming this, reselect this feature and the web part will be updated.
