## Bug Fixes

### Data Protection

- **Password Protection for Platform Level Backup Data**

In the previous version of DocAve, security policies could not be applied to platform level backup data. This has been fixed in this release.

- **Platform Level Backup Data Size Error**

When platform level backup data was stored on a TSM device, the data-size button and job reports occasionally showed errors in the amount of content stored in the device.

- **Limitation in using SQL Mirroring or Log Shipping in High Availability**

If a database had been backed up in a platform level backup plan prior to setting up a High Availability plan, you could not save the plan.

### Administration

- **Report Center - Admin Reports Not Scheduleable at Farm Level**

Previously, scheduled admin reports had to be generated on site collection level or lower. The Farm level can now be selected for running a farm-wide report.

### Migration

- **End-User Migration Web Part**

The previous migration feature did not include the proper security certificate, resulting in an Active-X error when loading the web part in SharePoint. This has been resolved in the latest package.

## Known Issues

### General

- **License Update Requirement**

Due to enhanced license control, all previous users who were running DocAve v5 with Platform Level Backup enabled, you must request a new full license from support to enable this feature. Please e-mail [support@avepoint.com](mailto:support@avepoint.com) for more information.

- **Usage of SQL Server for the DocAve Application Database**

DocAve does not support storing application data or audit data in SQL Server 2000. Only versions 2005 and 2008 are supported. The built-in structured data file format is still the recommended setting for database location (default).

- **Installing the User Clustering and End-User File System Web Parts**

In order to complete the update to these web parts, please go to the Agent Configuration Tool, un-check the Administration and File System Migration boxes (respectively), and click the "confirm" button to restart all DocAve Agent services. Re-check these options and press confirm again, you will then be able to run the latest version of these tools in SharePoint.

## Data Protection

- **Platform Level Backup of Global Assembly Cache (GAC)**

DocAve's out-of-place restore functionality for the GAC in platform level backups is not supported. Please use the Front-End Deployment Manager for this functionality.

- **Granular Restore of Minor Versions - Support Limitation**

When performing a restore of minor versions, the corresponding major version must first be restored to SharePoint. This is a known limitation and will be addressed in the next release.

## Administration

- **Batch Creation of Site Collections in Mixed WSS v3 and MOSS 2007 Environments**

DocAve does not support creating multiple site collections in both a WSS v3 and MOSS 2007 environment at the same time from the Central Administration module. Please create these site collections separately.

## Migration

- **End-User File System Migration - Support for Picture Libraries**

DocAve does not support uploading content to a picture library in this version.
